Titus 2:7-10

Make yourself an example of good works with integrity and dignity in your teaching. ⁸ Your message is to be sound beyond reproach, so that any opponent will be ashamed, because he doesn't have anything bad to say about us.

⁹Slaves are to submit to their masters in everything, and to be well-pleasing, not talking back ¹⁰or stealing, but demonstrating utter faithfulness, so that they may adorn the teaching of God our Savior in everything. Titus 2:7-10

Weekly Discussion Guide

- This portion of scripture comes on the heels of an exhortation for older men and women to conduct themselves in specific ways while also instructing the younger generation. Why do you think Paul then turns around and instructs Titus directly?

- Pastor Scott said that the way you live will either confirm or deny your message. Have you found that to be true in your own life? Can you think of an example where you saw this play out in someone else's life (good or bad)? What was your takeaway after witnessing that?

- Daniel was given as an example of living life above reproach. In Daniel 6, the high officials and satraps observed Daniel closely to find grounds to accuse him, but they were unsuccessful. If these same high officials and satraps were sent to observe your own life (work and home), what kind of report would they give? Where are you aligning with the examples of Daniel and Titus? Where do you need to grow?

- Do you agree with the logic that good works will prove the genuineness of your faith, which will in turn prove God's existence to the unbelieving world around you? If yes, how could this change the way you approach your work?

- Read verses 9-10. How does this type of slavery differ from the pre-civil war type slavery that we typically think of? Discuss how Paul is speaking truth and life into an existing system without condoning the practice. Then, discuss how this exhortation can apply to our 21st century employer-employee relationships.

- Finally, Pastor Scott encouraged us that (in the case of Daniel), God turned an entire pagan nation to worship Him because of the faithful witness of one man. How can your current position draw people to Jesus?
