Revelation 19:6-10

6Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, "Hallelujah!

For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns.

7Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready;

8it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure" — for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.

9And the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." **10**Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God." For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. (ESV)

Life Group Leader Notes:





- Recall your favorite wedding story - one you have attended or your own. Why is the Wedding Supper of the Lamb the most important wedding you will ever attend?
- The white robes were given to the Church (Rev. 6:11, Rev. 19:8) and yet they also made themselves ready (Rev. 19:7). How can we explain this pure and blameless position before God?
- Consider that we have turned the corner in the book of Revelation. From here on we will see Satan defeated, the evil finally judged, and Christ reigning as the King of Heaven over His united Church. This is really going to happen one day. What temporary worries or fears do you carry that can be put to rest knowing this future end?
- Do you find yourself trying to fit into your circles? To blend into trends and goals and causes that distract? How are those distractions preparing you to meet Christ at the marriage supper? What can we occupy our time with that would benefit our future reunion with him?
- "The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." Pastor Scott said this likely referred to the stories throughout the Spirit-inspired Scripture that testify to Jesus. How are your personal devotions in the Word testifying about Jesus? How are they pointing to the consummation that happens in Revelation 19-22?
- In verse 10, John was overwhelmed with the vision and fell to worship at the feet of the angel. But the angel refused the worship and pointed him to God. Compare the instincts of this angel to the instincts of Satan. Do you ever long to receive the adoration and praise of others, or are you quick to point people's attention to God? How can you develop this instinct to point people to God?
- Take a few minutes to read through the seven blessings of the book of Revelation (1:3; 14:13; 16:15; 19:9; 20:6; 22:7; 22:14). What do you learn about God from this list? What do you learn about yourself? How do these blessings encourage you to persevere?
