Life Group Leader Notes:





•The entire purpose of John's gospel is to *believe* in Christ. How would you define "belief?" In his comment on John 6:35, Pastor Cam said that *coming* and *believing* are one in the same. How does this help you understand what true belief is?

•Many people who heard the original sermon in John 6 walked away from Jesus because it was a hard teaching (6:60). The gift they hoped to receive from Jesus was *different* from the gift he was offering to them. As Pastor Cam said, their desires were "earth bound." Do you ever have earth-bound desires when you come to Jesus? Think about the nature of your prayers. Are they focused on food that perishes or food that endures to eternal life (6:27)?

•Have you ever "sinned against the light"? How did you handle that offense?

•Has there been a time in your life when you wondered if God would forgive you? Or have you had a friend who has asked this question? How does Jesus respond to that question according to this text?

•Pastor Cam said that one of the themes of the Gospel of John is God's sovereign hand in the saving, satisfying, and securing His people. There is an invitation to all and Christ welcomes us. What does this text teach us about human responsibility within the context of God's sovereignty?

•"Christ sincerely welcomes you to come and rest in His eternal security." How should it change our outlook on life if we know that His people are secure in His arms? How can we rest in this security this week? Is there a friend in your life that needs to be reminded of this?
